Designer-led Rembaum Hanau gallery unveils in downtown New York

Brought together by a decorative arts course, interior designer and AD PRO Directory member Sharon Rembaum and French textile designer Cécile Hanau have unveiled a gallery dedicated to collectible furniture, lighting, art, and objects in New York's Tribeca neighborhood. Housed in a regal prewar building, the Rembaum Hanau showroom reflects the founders' European sensibilities and zeal for eclectic flea markets. It's stocked with one-of-a-kind antique and vintage pieces from around the world, like an early 1900s elm Mahjong table, a circa-1930s brass-and-glass Gio Ponti bar cart, and a leather-wrapped midcentury floor lamp by Jacques Adnet for Valenti. The duo dynamically pairs the finds with contemporary works, including agateware by British potter Peter Wills.
